Successful unconventional shale exploration and production is dependent on hydraulic fracturing. However, concerns over environmental issues related to exploitation in and adjacent to beneficial use ground water is of growing concern in California as represented by the passage of Senate Bill 4 and the ensuing Environmental Impact Report. Having a strategy in place to document baseline environmental and particularly groundwater conditions prior to exploration can help

manage risk. This presentation will address experience gained in the United States shale exploration regions related to baseline groundwater sampling. Weston's experience indicates that collecting a representative set of samples from groundwater supply wells within a defined radius around a well pad prior to drilling activities provides the operator with information that documents predrilling groundwater conditions. Performing this type of baseline sampling within a well-designed, scientifically and legally defendable program can help the operator manage and mitigate corporate risk.

Technical Speaker Topic: 3D Casing Graphing



With advancements in wireline technology, the ability to acquire down hole wellbore schematics and problems has become essential to a well's maintenance after completion. When experiencing problems in a wellbore there are several options to determine what may be wrong with the well. If a problem exists in the pipe, a caliper log is often utilized to analyze pipe integrity, anomalies and radial dimensions. A caliper tool is equipped with spring loaded feelers that run along the inside of the pipe. These readings are then recorded and analyzed to determine the quality of the pipe.

The Multi-Finger Imaging Tool (MIT) is an advanced caliper that mechanically measures the inner diameter of pipe in a wellbore with high accuracy. The MIT identifies normal wear and tear such as corrosion, scale build up, and pitting as well as a wide array of features such as perforation mapping, restrictions, holes, up to split and parted casing. The tool's precision accuracy outputs both a 2 and 3 dimensional log that can be used to determine what size tools should be conveyed to remediate any problems. The post-processing software provides a 3D log of the wellbore including X-Y dimensions. The remainder of the 2 dimensional data provides analysis of each pipe joint which is tabulated and indexed for interpretation.

As the lead Logging Engineer at Tiger Cased Hole Services, Kenji Yamazawa manages regional logging operations. With extensive knowledge of the logging technologies, he leads Tiger's training and development department. Kenji's curriculum allows for both extensive classroom and field training of junior field engineers. Data acquisition, servicing and rebuilding of gamma ray and neutron tools, Cement bond evaluation tools, pressure-temperature-spinner tools, and a variety of caliper tools, including the Multi-finger Imaging Tool being discussed tonight are often part of his program. Kenji received his graduate degree in Mechanical Engineering from California State Polytechnic University of Pomona and hoping to pursue his Masters focusing on Petroleum in the near future.





BASIC CORROSION - May 5-9, 2014

The Basic Corrosion Course focuses on corrosion and the potential problems caused by corrosion. It provides a basic but thorough review of causes of corrosion and the methods by which it can be identified, monitored, and controlled. Active participation is encouraged through hands-on experiments and case studies, as well as an open discussion format. The course is held 8-5 Mon - Thurs, with a comprehensive open-book exam on Fri morning.

Course highlights include but are not limited to: Basics of Electrochemistry, Types of Environments, Engineering Materials , Forms of Corrosion, Corrosion Control & Prevention Methods, Testing & Monitoring Techniques

DESIGNING FOR CORROSION CONTROL - May 11-15, 2014

The Designing for Corrosion Control Course reviews the principles of corrosion and corrosion control and provides a systematic method for applying the technology of corrosion prevention to the design process. It offers an overview of the steps involved in materials selection common to many industries. It also covers the economic considerations of including corrosion control in system design and the financial principles used in evaluating alternative materials and designs. No prior training is required. However, for those with a limited corrosion background, the NACE Basic Corrosion Course is recommended prior to taking this course. The course is held 8-5 Mon - Thurs, with a comprehensive open-book exam on Fri morning.






