PAY ATTENTION LIST GET INVOLVED

Clark's Corner is back and will be sharing info with you all from time to time, thanks for the opportunity. There are several issues you should be aware of and hopefully respond accordingly. I'm talking about the negative impacts on our industry. The following items are examples:

SB 32 (Pavley)-Requires the Air Resources Board (ARB) to approve statewide greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions limits equivalent to 40% below the 1990 level by 2030 and 80% below the 1990 level by 2050.

SB 350 (DeLeon)-Enacts the "Clean Energy and Pollution Reduction Act of 2015, "which establishes targets to reduce petroleum use in motor vehicles by 50% by 2030, double the energy efficiency of buildings by 2030, and increase retail sales of renewable electricity to 50% by 2030.

Department of Fish & Wildlife – Oil Spill Prevention and Response Planning (OSPR). Must prepare an oil spill contingency plan and submit the plan to the administration by January 1, 2016. Website - https://www.wildlife.ca.gov/OSPR/Legal/Proposed-Regulations

Bureau of Land Management (BLM) – Onshore Order 3 Site Security. Proposed changes that could have significant impacts: a number of immediate assessments for infractions, new seal requirements and many changes in commingling approvals. Public comments of the rule is due by September 11, 2015. Website - http://www.regulations.gov/#!documentDetail;D=BLM-2015-0003 -0001

We still have ongoing controversial issues with the Regional & Sate Water Control Board, Division of Oil and Gas, and CARB.

Major Impact: The Kern County Planning and Community Development Department has prepared the draft environmental report for the revisions to the Kern County Zoning Ordinance – 2015 C, focused on Oil and Gas Local Permitting. The comment period closes on **September 11**, **2015**. Website - http://pcd.kerndsa.com/planning/oil-gas-zoning-amendment






