His latest book is *Cave Paintings and the Human Spirit: The Origin of Creativity and Belief* (Prometheus Books, 2009). His publications have been translated into 5 languages beyond English.

Dr. Whitley has written nominations for 470 sites that are now listed on the *National Register of Historic Places* (NRHP), as well the 100 site Carrizo Plain Archaeological *National Historic Landmark* (NHL) District, approved in 2012. For a decade he served on the Council of Directors of the ICOMOS International Rock Art Committee, and has represented the United States at a variety of international UNESCO meetings. He was made a *Fellow* of the American Anthropological Association in 1993, and in 2001 he received the Society for California Archaeology's *Thomas King Award for Excellence in Cultural Resource Management*.

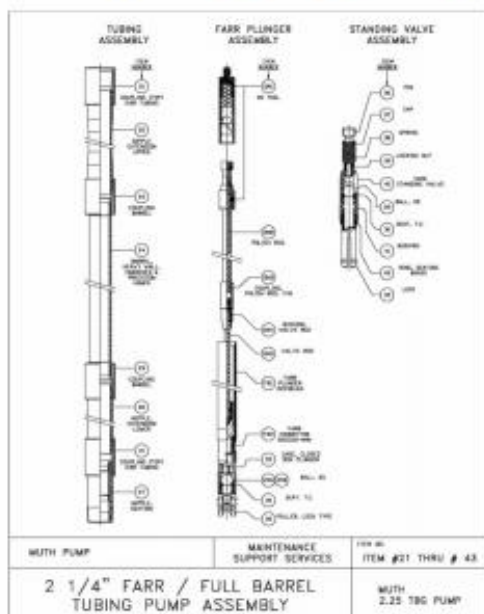

5. Essay: Please submit a short essay of approximately 500 words for the essay questions and 200 words for the informational question that are found later in the application.
6. Email Documents: Applications will be required to be emailed to all committee members. Scan and attach all documents. Transcripts and letters of recommendations can be sent via U.S. Mail if needed. If it is necessary that you need to mail the application, we will accept it, but the preference is by email. 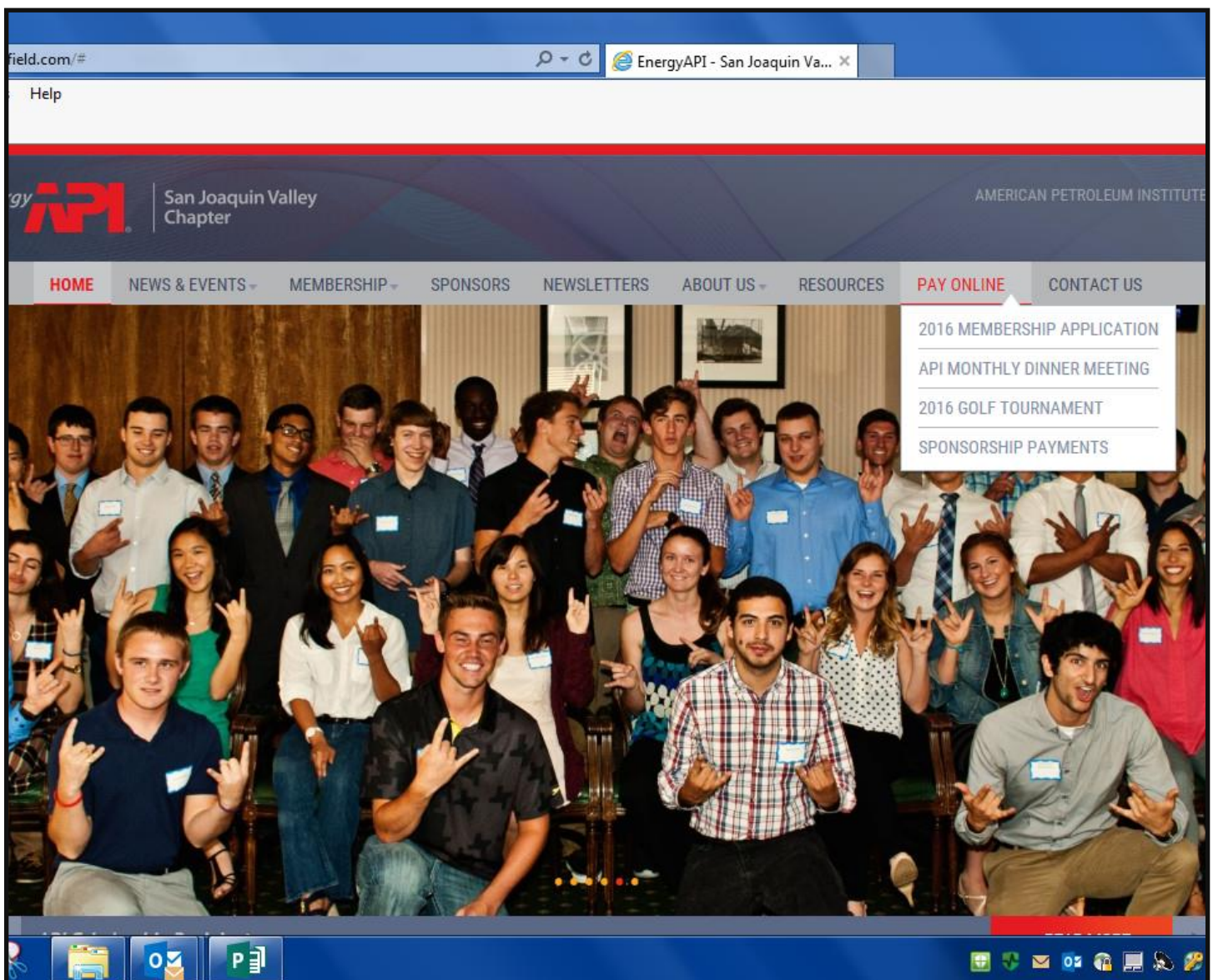
