She previously served as associate dean of the College of Liberal Arts and chair of the

Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Drew University in Madison, New Jersey. Madden has a book appearing later this year and has written multiple research articles in the field of symbolic dynamical systems. 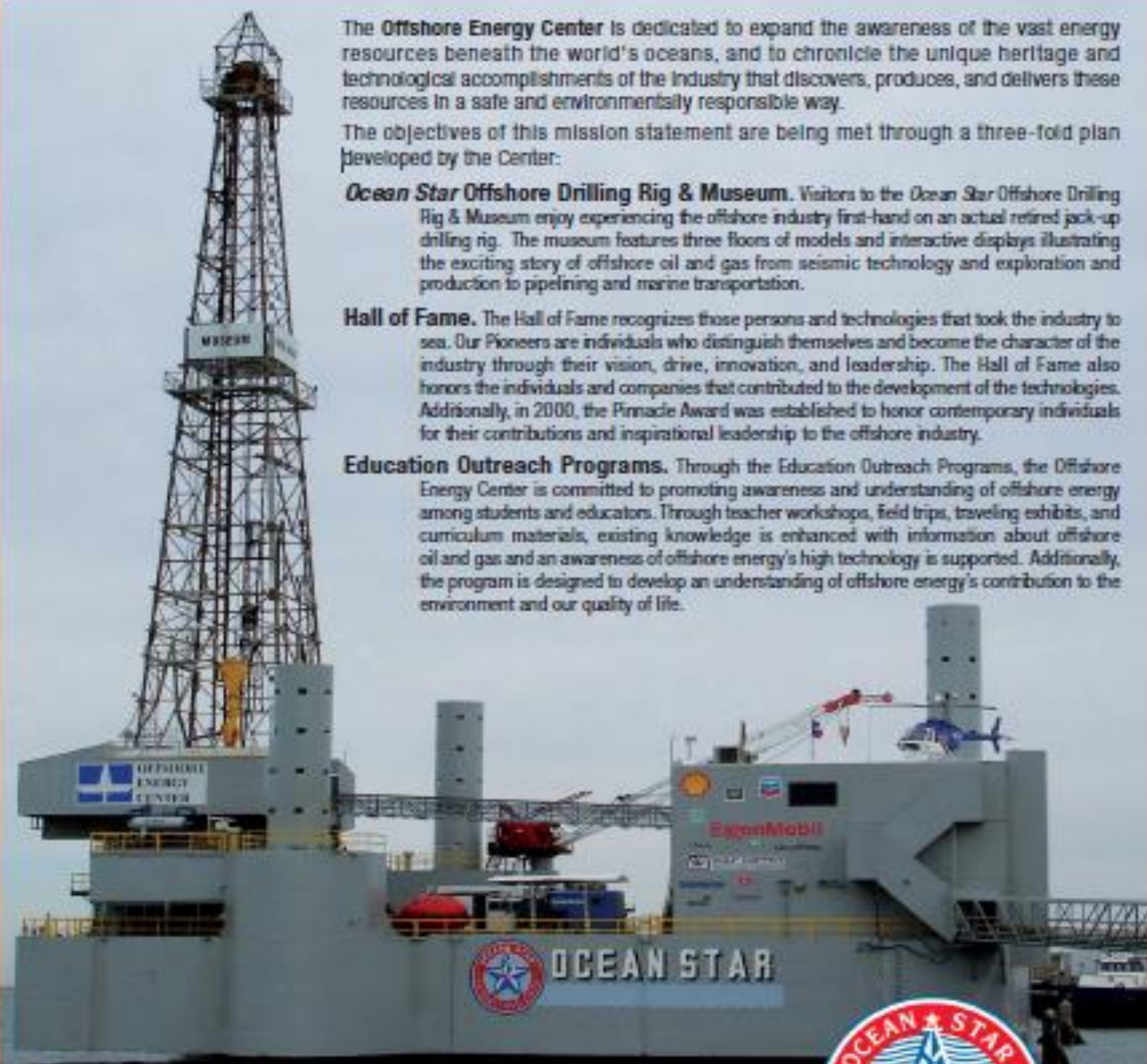

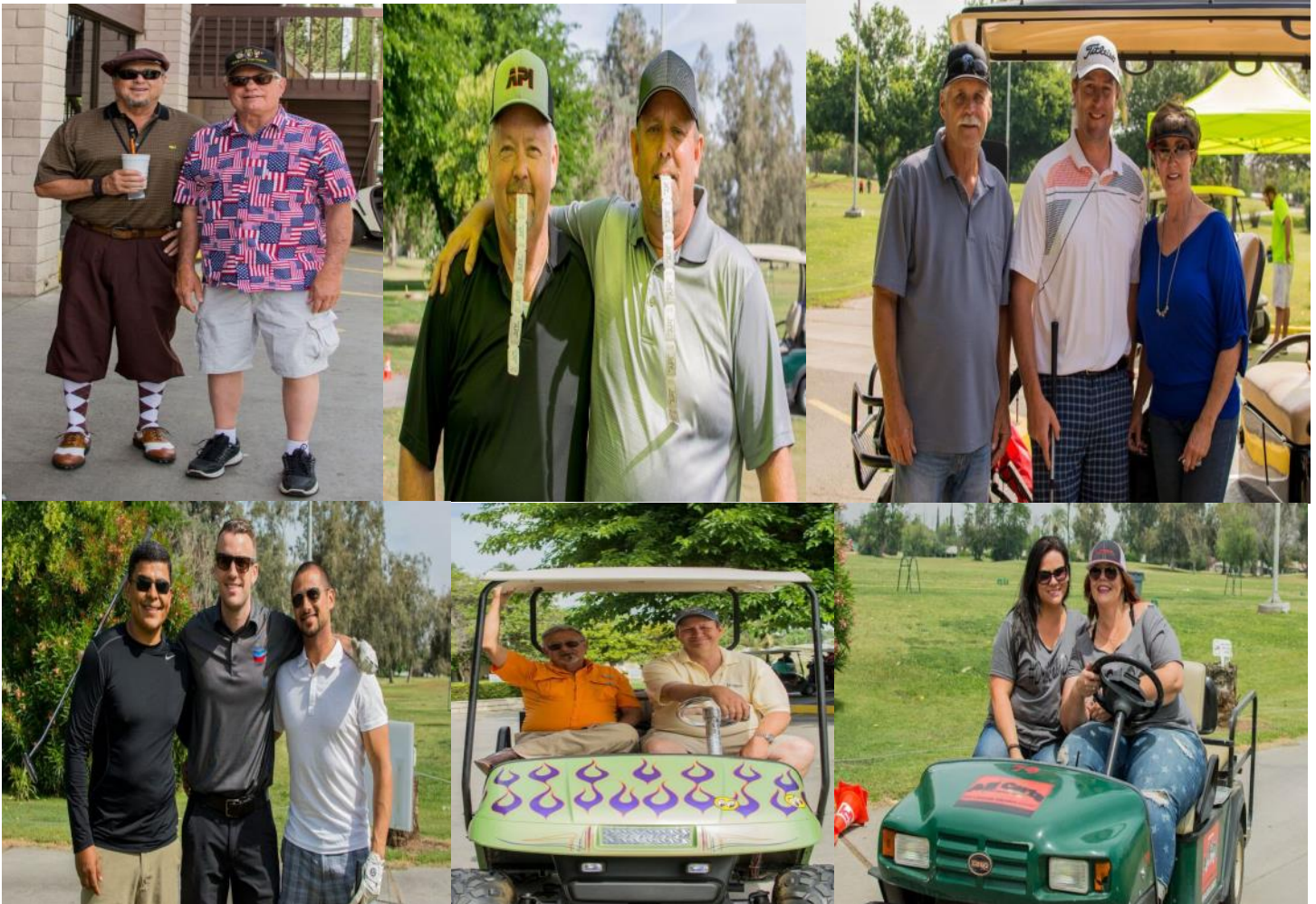

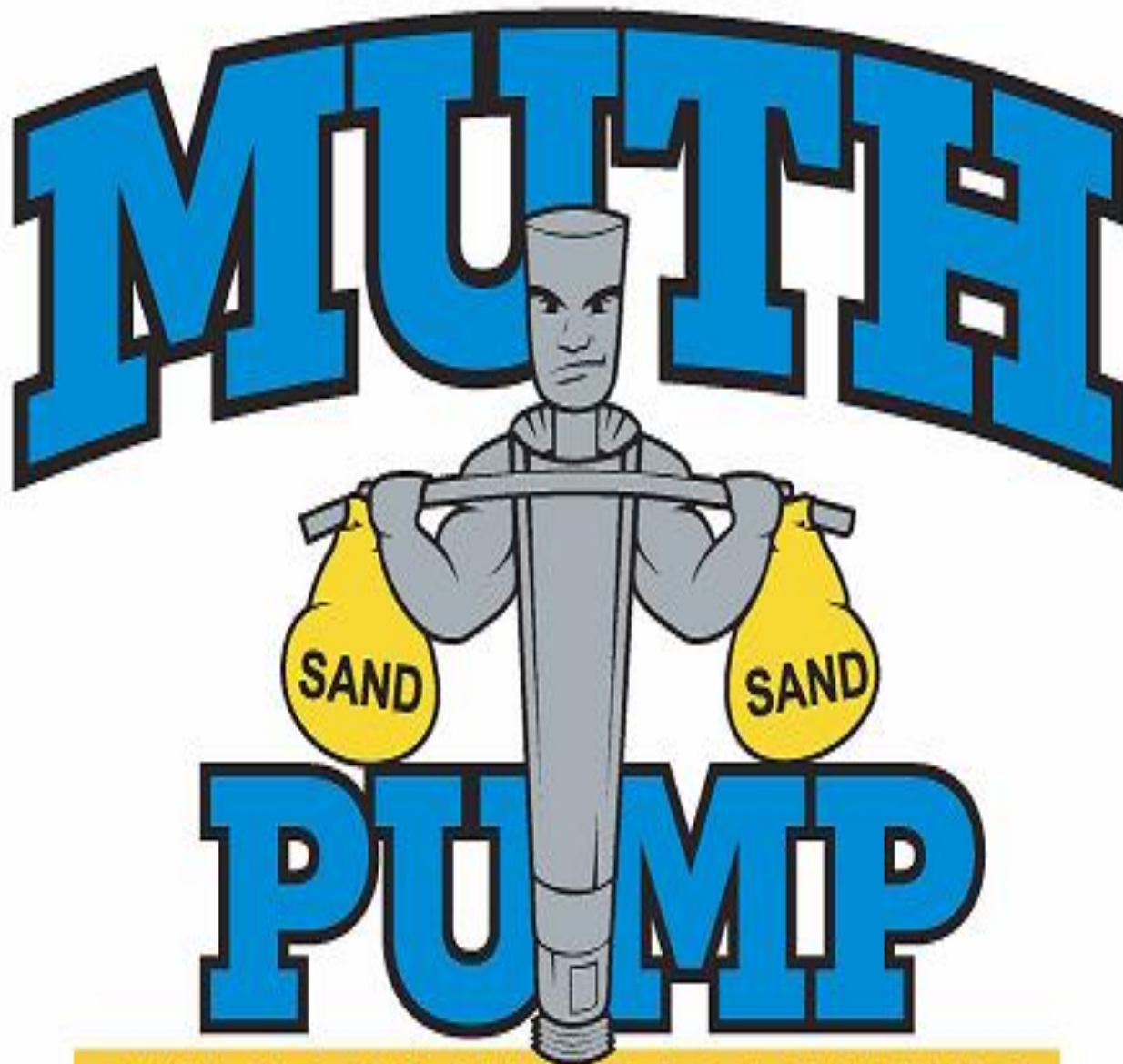
