

# Topic: "Engineering at CSUB."



Kathleen Madden, who has been serving as interim dean and professor of mathematics in NSME since June 2016, has been appointed as NSME dean. Madden earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics from the University of Colorado and a master's degree and PhD, both in mathematics, from the University of Maryland. She previously served as associate dean of the College of Liberal Arts and chair of the

Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Drew University in Madison, New Jersey. Madden has a book appearing later this year and has written multiple research articles in the field of symbolic dynamical systems. A Happy June to Everyone,


