Russell has always called Bakersfield "home" and returned to the Valley in 2002. He worked as a district representative for a California State Senator until he left for the private sector in 2005. At that time, he was appointed to the Bakersfield Planning Commission, serving from August 2005 to April 2009. In 2007, he was asked to serve as Kern County Supervisor Mike Maggard's chief of staff, a position he held until December 2009. In November 2010, Russell was elected to the Bakersfield City Council. He represented the City's 7th ward until the end of his term in December of 2014. Russell operates his own public affairs and government relations firm, Common Sense Consulting. His client base includes large corporations, business trade associations, and everyday citizens that need help cutting through the red tape of government. Community service has always been a passion of Russell's. He has served on various non-profit boards including the Boys and Girls Club of Kern County Foundation. Russell acts as chairman of the NOR Chamber of Commerce Legislative Committee as well as the Kern County Hispanic Chamber of Commerce Government Affairs Committee and is a board member of a local Foster Family Agency, Homes of Hope. Russell's family has a long legacy in Bakersfield. His grandfather, Bill Park, served on the Bakersfield City Council in the late 60's. He and his wife Susanne have two boys Ryan and Benjamin.



Garold Muth Named as Honorary Lifetime Member



Garold Muth has been named as an Honorary Lifetime Member of the San Joaquin Valley Chapter of the API. He will be honored and inducted at the October General Meeting.

Following five years in the Navy, Garold has been involved in the oil industry since he went to work for Texaco in the Castaic Area in 1963. He started as a roustabout and during his 55-year career in the oil industry he worked for several different

companies in a variety of areas and increasing responsibilities. Some of the companies are Texaco, Shell, Mobil, Century Oil, Gulf, and Callon Petroleum.

He founded Muth Pump Company in January 1995 and is still active in the company as he keeps tabs on his son David to make sure he is doing things the right way. Muth Pump LLC is the OEM of the FARR Plunger and Garold holds several patents that address fundamental flaws in traditional Rod Pump Designs.

Garold has been an active member of the API since May of 1997. Although he has never served on any of the committees or the board itself, he has been an avid API supporter by sponsoring events like the golf tournaments, Fall Fun Shoot, Socials, and much more. He has provided food for the Fall Fun Shoot for the past several years along with bag sponsorships for other events and has sponsored family dinners for Scholarship night. Garold has also been a presenter for tech sessions on several occasions and has inventions for the petroleum industry that have helped to reduce the cost of production with rod pumps which has helped the industry as a whole. Other efforts to give back to the petroleum industry include donating a working downhole pump model to Montana Tech University for their Petroleum Engineering Class.

Oil Can Do It Food Drive Sets Another Record!

The Oil Can Do It food drive concluded at the end of August and was very successful, setting new records in contributions to the Golden Empire Gleaners. The drive raised a total of \$161,888 and 32,549 pounds of food, for an equivalent total of 356,327 pounds of food. This is over 100,000 pounds more than last year's record total of 227,354 pounds.

The food drive participants were Aera, Chevron, CRC and API. Our API team included 22 oil and oil service companies. Led by Berry Petroleum, our API team tripled our 2017 contribution of 21,000 pounds and brought in 62,900 pounds. The entire team list is included in the newsletter as a separate attachment. Below is a snapshot of this year's results and some results from prior years. Note that API has been involved in the 2017 and 2018 campaigns and collected the most actual food both years.






