The Rural Crime Investigation Unit is a dedicated unit responsible for investigating crimes in the agriculture, oil and livestock industries in Kern County. Tanner also belongs to the California Rural Crime Prevention Task Force, which is an organization of law enforcement and regulatory agencies, along with corporate partners dedicated to the reduction and prevention of rural crime.
