Presentation Description:

The U.S. has achieved the long sought-after goal of energy independence, but California, and most of the world, now despise fossil fuels, or hydrocarbons. How did so many people come to the conclusion that carbon dioxide is bad? Is less carbon really the answer, and is there a pathway back to

sanity?

Dave Kilpatrick is President of Kilpatrick Energy Group, which invests in oil and gas ventures and provides strategic consulting services to the energy industry. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of Cheniere Energy Inc., a publicly traded company which is the largest exporter of liquefied natural gas in the United States. Dave also serves as Senior Advisor to BlackRock TCP Capital Corporation. Dave is on the Board of two private oil and gas companies — PetroRock LLC, and Mustang Resources, LLC. He has also served on the Board of Directors of Breitburn Energy, Applied Natural Gas, Woodbine Acquisition Corp., Whittier Energy, and PYR Energy.

Dave was formerly President and Chief Operating Officer of Monterey Resources, the largest independent oil and gas company in California until its merger with Texaco. He held various management positions with Santa Fe Energy Resources in California and Texas.






