Zero Carbon Steam for Oil Fields and Refineries - Opportunities to lower fuel costs and crude oil carbon intensity with Solar Steam from Rondo Heat Batteries.

Rondo has developed a "new tool in the decarbonization toolbox": a zero-carbon source of industrial process heat. Our technology captures intermittent solar power (or grid power during very low price periods) and delivers continuous high-temperature heat. That heat can replace the combustion of natural gas across a wide range of processes. We're delivering oilfield steam generators that are direct, drop-in replacements for conventional OTSGs. Because of the plunging price of solar power, and the rising costs of trade and the Low Carbon Fuel Standard, switching to zero-carbon steam is very profitable. Kern County is home base for us in engineering and fabrication, and is the place where we think we can make the biggest, fastest contribution. Beyond straight OTSGs, we're developing projects that will provide zero-carbon heat for carbon capture systems, oil refineries, food producers, and cement manufacturers.

Jeremy Keller, P.E., is the VP of Project Development for Rondo Energy. Prior to Rondo, Jeremy spent 10 years with Ameresco developing and delivering energy efficiency and renewable energy projects for commercial and industrial facilities, with a focus on water, wastewater, food processing and biogas projects. He is a licensed mechanical engineer in the State of Washington with expertise in the design and technical applications of energy storage, solar photovoltaics, microgrids, renewable natural gas and HVAC systems. Jeremy earned an MBA from Oregon State University, and bachelor's degrees in Mechanical Engineering and Physics from the University of Washington.



A solution, combine these 'plants!'

A commercial pilot is planned in California to grow algae, a type of green plant, using CO_2 from boiler flue gas. The produced algae is a valued commodity that will be sold to customers. About 90% of the combustion CO_2 will be consumed by the algae.



Pyles Boys Camp BBQ Returns to Raise Money to Support At-Risk Youth

The annual Pyles Boys Camp BBQ returns to help raise money to support programs that help low-income, disadvantaged boys through a no-cost, multi-year wilderness camp supplemented by year-round mentoring.






