In 2016, Vince Fong was elected to represent the 34th Assembly District, which encompasses most of Kern County.

Vince serves on the following Assembly committees: Budget Committee (Vice Chair), Transportation Committee (Vice Chair), Appropriations Committee, and Business and Professions Committee

Vince began his career with Congressman Bill Thomas, Chair of the Ways and Means Committee, working on international trade policy. He then returned home to serve the residents of Kern County.

For nearly a decade, Vince served as the district director to House Leader and Congressman Kevin McCarthy, until Vince was elected to the State Assembly in 2016.

Vince is a lifelong resident of Kern County. He earned a bachelor's degree from UCLA and masters from Princeton University. He serves on the boards of the Jim Burke Education Foundation and Honor Flight Kern County where he works to send WWII, Korean War and Vietnam Veterans to Washington, DC to see their memorials.

Technical Session

Using One Stone to Kill Two Birds Economic + Sustainability Needs

Electric utility costs represent more than 25% of LOE and facility operating expenses. The electricity rate hike approved by the California Public Utilities Commission last month taking effect, will significantly increase, by as much as 10%, costs for California businesses.

Oil and gas producers, agricultural, water(+ oilfield produced water) and sewage treatment industries using the grid to power all or some of their

operations will be adversely affected. How will they determine the impact of such increment to their lifting / marginal costs objectively and realistically? I will share how this can be achieved and other advanced strategies that will help engineering and management teams:

- Determine their lifting / marginal costs in real time helping them better manage the current spike in electricity prices + manage downtimes + help support M&A due diligence processes.
- Better manage and support their scope 2 emissions reporting programs ESG.
- Validate their energy efficiency improvements projects and critical equipment performance.

Chijioke (CJ) Ejimuda is a second generation oil and gas professional. He started his oilfield career as a reservoir engineer with ExxonMobil and a brief stint supporting AERA's Ventura production operations. He has conducted extensive Autonomous Drilling research leveraging Autonomous Vehicle technology stack which was captured on his poster presentation at SPE Gulf Coast data science convention in 2019. He has presented at SPE, AAPG conferences and authored numerous publications that leverages big data, IIoT, AI/ML, computer vision, robotics and autonomous vehicle technology stacks. Besides OnePetro and AAPG Search and Discovery publications, Hybrid Data's YouTube and LinkedIn slide shares are excellent resources to gain more knowledge of his work.

Currently, he is a Principal at Hybrid Data LLC, a data driven engineering and technology advisory and implementation consulting company that leverages emerging technologies - big data, IIoT, AI/ ML, computer vision, robotics and most recently, financial technology (FinTech) to deliver turnkey solutions helping clients address operational challenges in energy, utilities and transportation (+rail) markets.






