

Subject: Support for EPA's proposal to issue four (4) Class VI Underground Injection Control (UIC) permits for California Resources Corporation (CRC)

I am writing to let you know about an opportunity to comment during workshops hosted by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA's) Region 9 and Kern County Planning and Natural Resources Agency in February and March 2024.

This is an opportunity for you to comment on the EPA's proposal to issue four (4) Class VI Underground Injection Control (UIC) permits for California Resources Corporation (CRC) subsidiary Carbon TerraVault to construct and operate injection wells for geologic sequestration of carbon dioxide.

The proposed injection wells will be located within the Elk Hills Oil Field approximately 20 miles west of Bakersfield, California. The permit would authorize injection of carbon dioxide into the proposed injection wells at a depth of approximately 6000 feet.

There will be 4 joint workshops (see table below for dates and locations) where agencies will present information about EPA's UIC permitting process, the proposed UIC permits and Kern County's draft Environmental Impact Report.

The public hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, from 6:00pm – 9:00pm PST at the Buttonwillow Recreation and Park District.

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
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

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
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
